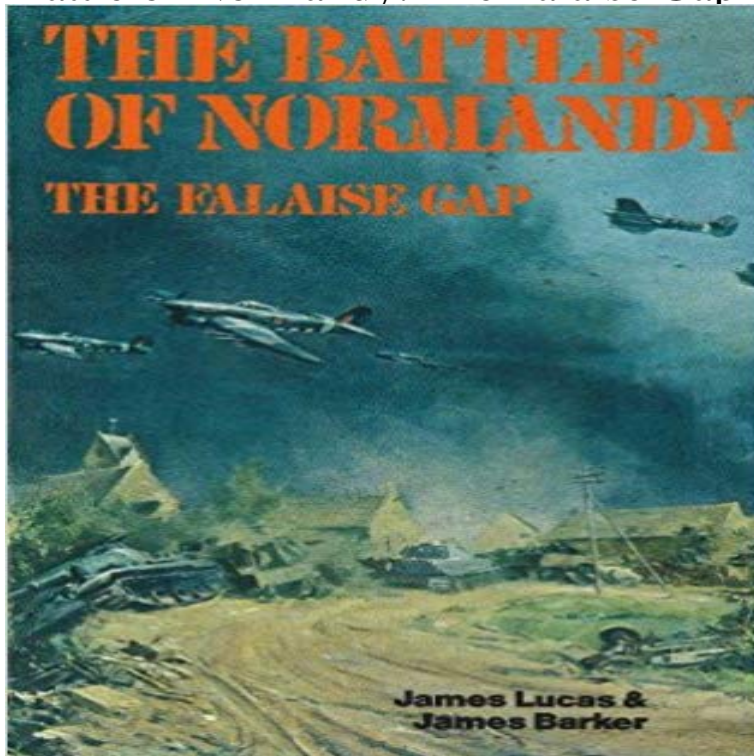


## Battle of Normandy: The Falaise Gap
