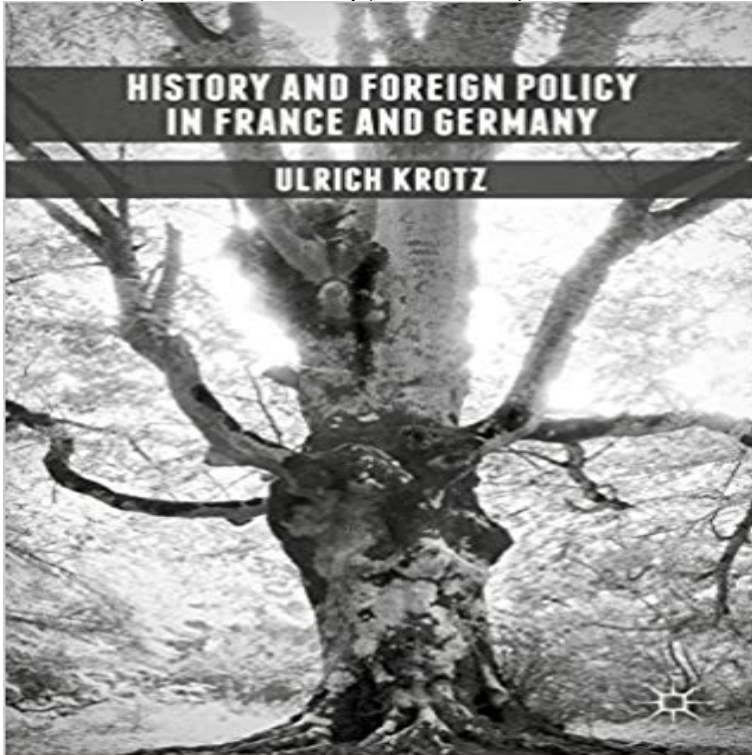


History and Foreign Policy in France and Germany
