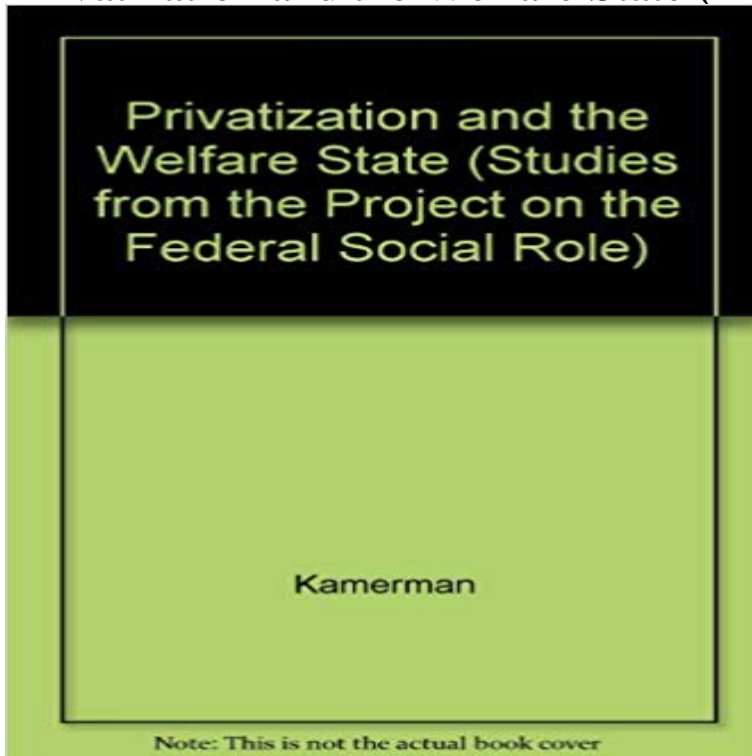


Privatization and the Welfare State (Princeton Legacy Library)
